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
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DISCOVERING LE HAVRE



A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY

On 7th February 1517, François Ist commissioned Admiral Bonnivet to build a fortified port in Lieu-de-Grâce. The city of Le Havre was officially created on 8th October 1517 when François Ist signed the charter of foundation of the city to be built in Port-de-Grâce.



LE HAVRE, A UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

From the town centre to the beach, the city was destroyed by the bombing in 1944. Auguste Perret, an architect, was then commissioned to rebuild this part of the city. It is this rebuilt 150-hectare area that has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2005. The rebuilt centre forms the administrative, commercial and cultural centre of Le Hayre.

PERRET ARCHITECTURE, SIMPLE ARCHITECTURE?

"To reach the original beauty, the artist must rise in simplicity" Auguste Perret.

The architect renounced decorative art in favour of the simplicity and nobility of the materials.

His work is defined by structural classicism. Defender and promoter of concrete, he does not use any paint and uses the system known as "column-beam". His idea was to create a modular and completely transparent structure, so that no structural elements are hidden.



Dive into the 50's and discover the Perret architecture.

A show flat allows you to discover the facilities proposed to rehouse the inhabitants after the Second World War, it allows you to familiarise yourself with the city and its past (cf. p70).

LE HAVRE, GREATEST PORT IN FRANCE

→ The construction of the port, currently covering an area of 10,000 hectares, was at the origin of the foundation of the city of Le Havre. The port of Le Havre is the leading port in France for container traffic, the leading port

for foreign trade and the leading cruise port on the Atlantic coast. In addition, the Normandy region is the greatest seafront of France. It constitutes the leading port complex, as well as the leading French logistics





territory.

WHY ARE THERE SO MANY RESERVOIRS IN THE HARBOUR OF LE HAVRE?



→ The construction of these different basins is the consequence of the different phases of expansion of the port. Moreover, they have always followed the evolution of ships, from the 16th century to Port 2000. Real assets, these inland basins become marinas or leisure areas (sailing, stand-up paddle, rowing, etc.).

ARE THERE GREEN SPACES TO RECHARGE YOUR BATTERIES?



→ With 41m² of green space per inhabitant, there are many places in Le Havre and on the territory of the urban community such as the forest park of Montgeon, the park of Rouelles and the Jardins Supendus (Hanging Gardens), where you can recharge your batteries, have a picnic, ride a bike or practice sports.

WHAT ARE THE TYPICAL DISHES OF THE REGION?

→ The flagship products that you will find in Normandy dishes are apples, butter, cream, Camembert, cider and Calvados. Normandy is also the leading region for the production of oysters, mussels and scallops in France.

The cheese *Le petit Havrais* and the *Paillette* beer, local production since 1596, are also worth mentioning!



→ When you arrive in Le Havre, you can't miss the two huge chimneys overlooking the lower town.

Visible from the upper town and even as far as the landing beaches, they measure 240m. These chimneys are those of the EDF thermal power station. Since 2017, they have been lit at nightfall, with programmes that change throughout the year or during events taking place in the city.

THE PROCEDURES



INVENTORY OF FIXTURES

→ During the inventory of fixtures, take the time to go around the accommodation with the owner. Do not hesitate to ask questions and especially note any defects you may find.

THE SECURITY

DEPOSIT

→ The security deposit is paid to the lessor when the lease is signed and corresponds to one month's rent excluding charges for unfurnished accommodation. The amount will be returned at the end of the lease, within a period of one month if the inventory of fixtures of exit is in conformity with the inventory of fixtures of entry, or two months in the event of nonconforming inventory of fixtures of exit, deduction made of the possible damage noted, at the time of the restitution of the apartment. In the absence of a fixed and regular income, it is often

requested for a third party to act as a guarantor for the rental of an apartment.

For furnished accommodation, the deposit must not exceed 2 months' rent, excluding charges, and must be indicated in the rental contract (lease).

INSURANCE AND PROPERTY TAX

→ At the time of taking possession of the dwelling, it is obligatory to have taken out a home insurance policy. If you are a student and you have a dwelling on the 1st January of the year, you have to pay the housing tax for that dwelling. So remember to save-up! However, some student housing is exempt from property tax.

OPENING OF METERS AND LINES

→ After signing the lease, anticipate the opening of electricity and gas meters, if necessary. You can consult the list of access providers present in Le Havre on energie-info.fr

Don't forget the indispensable contract with an internet service provider to stay connected.

Tip: Remember to ask the landlord for the name of the former tenant, which is sometimes requested.

HOUSING SUBSIDIES

HOUSING SUBSIDIES FROM THE CAISSE **D'ALLOCATIONS FAMILIALES (CAF)**

→ First of all, in order to benefit from housing assistance and to claim aid from the CAF (Family Allowance Fund), you must already have found vour accommodation and be a tenant or co-tenant. Before applying for housing assistance, do an estimation on caf. fr, this will allow you to calculate, in a few minutes.

an estimate of the amount you will receive. As soon as you enter the premises. don't waste time, apply for housing assistance because it will only be effective from the month following your entry into the premises. The first payment is generally made two months after the application.

THE LOCA-PASS LOAN

→ THE LOCA-PASS loan is a zero-rate intended to cover all or part of the security deposit required by the owner when you enter the premises. The LO-CA-PASS guarantee acts as a security deposit for the landlord by covering the payment of the rent and charges in the event of non-payment.

THE STUDENT SOCIAL FILE (DSE) **OF THE CROUS**

→ The student social file is the procedure that allows students to apply, from a single file, for a bursary based on social criteria and/or accommodation in a university residence.

This file must be compiled each year from the etudiant. gouv.fr website, from 15 January to 31 May, for the following academic year.

VISALE

→ VISALE is a Housing Action device. It is a quarantee that facilitates access to housing for students and ensures that the landlord receives their rental income for the entire duration of the rental period in the event of default by the tenant. Young people between the ages of 18 and 30 are eligible, regardless of their situation.

How do I get the VISALE deposit? The process is at the initiative of the tenant. The adhesion to this rental guarantee is free and must be done before the signature of the lease. It can be filled out online on the Visale fr website.



The interview

Frédéric GARCIA

Scriptwriter and creator of the Netflix series **Mortel** shot in Le Havre

You're a 30-year-old screenwriter. What has been your background?

→ Coming from the Paris suburbs, nothing predestined me for the audiovisual professions. Following my degree in American literature and cinema. I obtained a master's degree in audiovisual production at the INA (Institut National de l'Audiovisuel). After two and a half vears in a short film and commercials production company, I felt like writing my own stories. It was only after developing a project with a scriptwriter that I entered a training program at the Femis de Paris - École nationale supérieure des métiers de l'image et du son - and then realised my dream of making it my profession. My career then took off.

Project *Mortel* was born. A series for teenagers. What's it for?

→ I started writing this story in 2009. Mortal was made possible thanks to a meeting with a producer who wanted to propose a fantasy series to Netflix. I never thought of it as a series for teenagers. You just create interesting characters and stay true to the story you want to tell. The very contemporary music and the aesthetics make this series a pop object that appeals to 13-25-year-olds. We also claim the French identity of the series by the absence of good-guy or bad-guy American-style characters, by the use of voodoo and of course by its sets.

How do you explain the choice of Le Havre?

→ The series should not be identified as taking place in a specific city. Le Havre offers a wealth of scenery and atmosphere with interesting suburban architecture, French-style housing estates, but also magnificent forests and wide open spaces. It is easier to shoot here in real settings than in the Paris region. Our production director had already filmed in Le Havre and I fell in love with this city, its inhabitants, the local extras and the film crew. Filming season 2 took three and a half months: it will show more of the maritime atmosphere of the city. See you in November 2020!

→ With 2 tramway lines, 21 bus lines and a funicular railway, the urban community of Le Havre Seine Métropole has a transport network so as to get about easily in the city centre and reach your main points of interest (beach, shops, museums...). Whether you are on foot or by bike, it is possible to mix all means of transport - train, LER, funicular, bus and tram - to get around the area easily.

- → No tickets are sold on board the tram: Ticket vending machines are available at the various stations.
- → To travel on the LiA network, vou must stamp your ticket each time you board the vehicle, including for connecting trips.
- → A TER (called LER) serves several communes of the urban community: Le Havre, Harfleur, Montivilliers, Épouville and Rolleville. For more information, contact the SNCF.

Bicycles only enter through the double doors in the middle of the vehicle and outside rush hours.

FUNICULAR

It closes every summer for a month for technical shutdown. It is possible to travel with your bike.

The tramway runs 7 days a week, all year round (except 1st May):

- → Sundays and holidays, from 6:00 a.m. to 12:30 a.m.

THE FUNICULAR

The funicular connects the lower town to the upper town of Le Havre. It runs 7 days a week, all year round (except 1st May):

- → Sundays and holidays from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

All LiA tickets are valid for use on the funicular. Special funicular tickets are also available.

→ To date, more than 135 km of secure cycling facilities allow vou to travel the territory.

STUDENT WELFARE REFORM

- > 16th March 2018 Directorate of Legal and Administrative Information (Prime Minister)
- → Act No. 2018 166 of 8th March 2018 on student guidance and success provides for the abolition of the student social security scheme by 31st August 2019. Student mutual insurance companies will be able to continue to offer complementary health services, as well as preventive actions on campus.
- → If you are a European student, you must use your European Health Insurance Card to access health care in France or apply for it at the relevant organisation.
- → However, depending on your situation, you may need to take other steps.

→ Before you leave, check with your affiliate organization and the French National Health Insurance.



What would be your best competition memory?


→ My best memory is without a doubt my first participation in the biggest standup paddleboarding race in California in 2017.

RAGGING IS AGAINST THE LAW!

Act No. 98-468 of 17 June 1998 on the prevention and punishment of sexual offences provides that:
« Except in cases of violence, threats or sexual offences, the fact that a person causes another person, against his or her will or otherwise, to suffer or commit humiliating or degrading acts during demonstrations or meetings related to the school and socio-educational environment is punishable by six months' imprisonment and a fine of €7,500. ». This offence is punishable by one year's imprisonment and a fine of €15,000 when committed on a minor or vulnerable person.

10 TIPS FOR MANAGING YOUR BUDGET

- 1. Do your accounting
 and draw up your budget
 each month: keep your
 credit card receipts, your
 bills and systematically
 fill in the stub of your
 cheque book
- 2. Plan from month to month what your future cash inflows and outflows will be in order to anticipate as well as possible any unexpected events.
- 3. Always pay your bills on time. In case of major financial problems, contact your creditors to find a solution.
- 4. Choose direct debit, which will allow you to limit problems in the event of unpaid bills.
- 5 Some invoices are sent every two months. If this is not convenient for you, you can pay monthly!

- 6. Avoid losing money on agios and bank charges and know that it is possible to negotiate an overdraft authorization with your banker. Don't overdo it, it will still cost you money.
- 7. If you have a positive balance in your current account at the end of the month, put the money in a savings account, even if the amount seems negligible!
- & Favour "available" savings where money can be released at any time
- 9. If you want to take out a loan to finance your education, consider a student loan.
- 10. Favour carpooling: more economical, more ecological and more friendly!







What is the partnership between Un Été au Havre and ESADHaR?

Jean Blaise → The idea is to integrate the existence of an active and interesting Beaux-Arts school on the territory we share into Un Été Au Havre. All the more so since artists we know teach there and that bringing them to Un Été Au Havre is as interesting for them as it is for us.

How are the artists selected to exhibit in a season?

Jean Blaise → Students who wish to do so are asked to make a proposal, then a selection is made. We reserve the right not to retain projects. We choose the projects according to a certain artistic quality and the respect of the creative principal of the work inside the city.

Our attention is focused on the appropriateness of the proposals according to the places treated, and this varies greatly from one artist to another. For example, we did not select a project for the 2020 season.

We are therefore carrying out a project from the previous edition which we had to give up for technical reasons: a creation by Alice Baude which floats in one of the basins in the centre of Le Havre.

Why is it important for ESADHaR to have its students exhibited at an international event?

Helen Evans → The collaboration with Un Été Au Havre gives incomparable visibility to our activity within the school. The Le Havre-Normandie Campus has a long tradition of art in the public space. Students are invited to work on projects that respond to a specific public context and to collaborate with cultural and scientific partners. Those selected as part of the Un Été Au Havre partnership learn a professional process of production and dissemination: tests and prototypes, working with manufacturers, thinking about the layout of the space...

The encounter between students and a local and international audience, through their own artistic productions, is an incredible opportunity.

Looking back on the 2019 edition, what has this operation changed in the careers of Antoine Dieu and Baptiste Leroux?

Helen Evans → For most artists, the career begins after graduation, but where to start is not easy to decide. The integration of Baptiste and Antoine into the official program of Un Été Au Havre marked the beginning of their activity and gave them the status of artist. But they are still students, and the path leading to an artistic career is often difficult and uneven. This first professional experience brings an impressive breadth to their body of work, attests to their ambition and professionalism and, most importantly, sends a strong signal that their vision of the world has already found a place in today's art scene. This first recognition by a renowned contemporary art curator is a tremendous springboard.

How does the general public view the creations of these local artists alongside internationally renowned artists

Jean Blaise → Insofar as, in our presentations and in our communication on the programming of Un Été Au Havre, we do not make a distinction between ESADHAR students and confirmed artists, visitors have the same view of the works of all the artists presented.

Helen Evans → To my knowledge, the fact that young art students exhibit alongside established artists on the international scene, with the same level of support and guidance, is a unique situation in the world, which breaks down the usual hierarchies.

This is a remarkable opportunity for generosity. The students' works have been well received by the press and presented to the public without any distinction between "local" and "international" young artists. In my opinion, it is important to present the "artists of the future".

And I hope that Le Havre will position itself as a fertile ground for creation in the greatest diversity of forms. This next generation of artists will invent other ways of doing things, points of reference and ways of thinking.

We choose projects according to a certain artistic quality. 99




